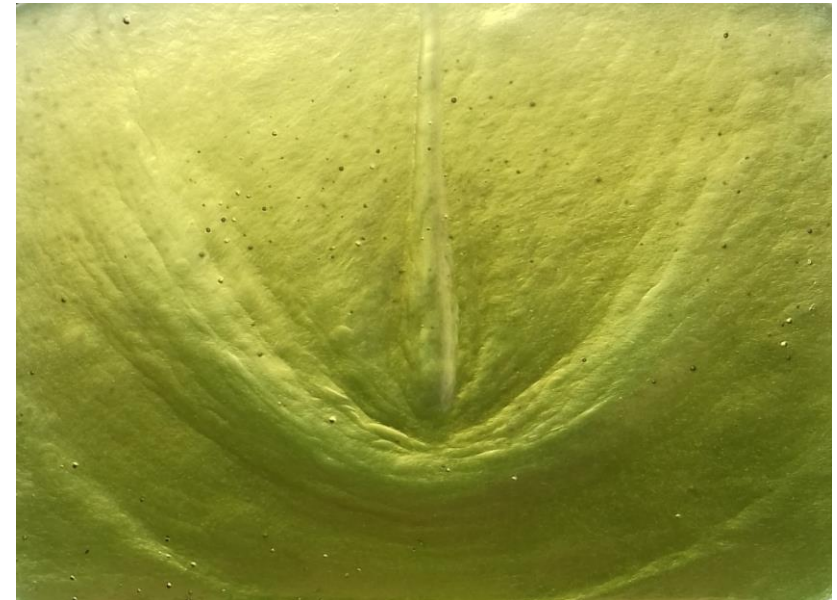

In August 2023, a new further training course begins to become a Metal Colour Light Therapist (de/en). The introductory seminar provides initial insights into this form of therapy.



**When the daylight shines through metal-coloured,
engraved glass - it immerses the viewer in spaces of light.**

Metals such as iron, gold, copper, silver, manganese and cobalt has been known for their healing properties for a long time. In the metal colour light glasses, they have become healing companions in a new way.

In the encounter with the colours of the metals and the light gestures of the motifs moved in colour, the observer can approach the warming, invigorating, strengthening and clarifying power of the metals.
